

Receiving New Journal Article/Table of Contents Alerts Delivered Automatically to via Email

Some of the Library's Research databases provide alert services which automatically send the table of contents of new issues of scholarly journals via email. Many of these services also send alerts for newly published articles on a specific topic (i.e. matching specific search terms).

Full-Text Journal Collections with Alert Services

Some of the Library's online journal subscriptions provide alert services which automatically send the table of contents of a new journal issue via electronic mail. Most of these email messages include links to the full-text of each article (which should work flawlessly on-campus).

To determine if the Library has an Online Subscription to a Journal:

1. Access the library's home page.
2. Choose Electronic Journals.
3. Search for the name of the desired journal.

To determine if the Journal has an automatic alert service:

1. Note the name of the name of the E-Journal Collection/Database.

Example:

from 02/01/1985 to present in Project Muse

Project Muse = Name of the service

2. See if the service is listed below.
